PRAYER FOR UNDERSTANDING

LITURGY OF THE PALMS (Responsive)

LITURGIST: When they had come near Jerusalem and had reached Bethphage, at the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them,

ONE: "Go into the village ahead of you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her; untie them and bring them to me. If anyone says anything to you, just say this, 'The Lord needs them.' And he will send them immediately."

LITURGIST: This took place to fulfill what had been spoken through the prophet, saying,

CHOIR: "Tell the daughter of Zion, Look, your king is coming to you, humble, and mounted on a donkey, and on a colt, the foal of a donkey."
