

Preschool Education Assistant and Christian Educator (PEACE Worker)

May 2024

Hours:	40 hours per week, including Sunday mornings
Compensation:	\$35,000-\$38,000/year, paid monthly
Supervision:	Reports to Preschool Director and Pastor as Head of Staff
Evaluation:	Annual review conducted by Personnel Committee and Pastor
Benefits:	flexible scheduling apart from preschool hours and other noted times, school scheduled breaks and 10 days PTO

Responsibilities:

Birth - Age 5

- Preschool
 - Assist preschool staff with children 3-5 years of age from 8am-1pm, Mon-Fri during the school year (160 days, 25 hrs/wk).
 - Attend required trainings and preschool events.
- Nursery Care for ages 0-5
 - Recruit, hire, train, and supervise childcare workers during worship

Elementary School

- Children's Sunday School for ages 5-11
 - Recruit, train, and supervise volunteer teachers for programming during worship.
 - Assemble curriculum and materials in consultation with Pastor.
 - Liaison with parents and other care-givers.
- Summer Vacation Bible School (VBS)
 - Recruit, train, and supervise volunteers.
 - Coordinate registration, promotion, and all other aspects of the program in conjunction with relevant committees of the church.
- Summer Camp
 - Encourage children and families to attend Stronghold camp in the summer.
 - Help coordinate carpools, registration, subsidies, etc.

Junior and Senior High

- Discipleship
 - Work with the Christian Education Committee to coordinate regular opportunities for fellowship, study and service.
 - Be a mentor to young people and help nurture them in faith.
- Confirmation Program
 - Encourage 8th & 9th graders to participate in the process.
 - Assist the pastor in coordinating classes, retreats, and celebrations.
 - Help recruit mentors from the congregation
- High School Mission Trip

- Coordinate with outside program providers as necessary to select dates, location, etc.
- Help recruit students and chaperones
- Assist with fundraising efforts such as the spring Spaghetti dinner.

Across the Ages

- Children & Youth in Worship
 - Work with Pastor and committees of the church to include children & youth in various aspects of worship such as by lighting candles, reading scripture, music, etc.
 - Coordinate Children's Messages in conjunction with Pastor.
 - Coordinate the children's Christmas Pageant.
- Intergenerational All-Church Retreat
 - Provide for children and youth programming during retreat weekend as needed.
 - Assist with promotion and registration
- Outreach
 - Help promote the church's children & youth programming in the community and online
 - Attend outreach activities of the church when available
- Other
 - Ensure the RPC Safe Church Policy is upheld at all times for the safety of both children and adult volunteers.
 - Attend staff meetings & committee meetings as needed.
